Liverpool Now 2006, running until next Friday (April 29), features workshops, seminars and mini-talks from musicians and music industry professionals, including Billy Bragg, So Solid Crew's producers and representatives of Sony BMG.

In partnership with MZONE, the youth music action zone, seminars will take place in the Rendall Building, University of Liverpool opposite Abercrombie Square.

This year's Liverpool Now also sees the launch of the new Picket venue on Jordan Street, in the Independence area of Liverpool.

Workshops will teach participants DJ-ing skills, singing techniques and music technology.

MZONE is hosting two seminars recruiting apprentices into music industry placements.

Phil Hayes, Liverpool Now's coordinator said: "Young people will not only have the opportunity to listen to top music industry personnel providing them with vital insights into the wonderful world of music.

"They will also be given the chance to perform at the world famous Cavern and the resurrected Picket Venue.
